

Korean Advanced Farmers' Federation (KAFF)

Established in December 1987, KAFF has around 176 member organizations and 130,000 individual members. It is dedicated to farmer care and upbringing and supports farmers through education and lobbying for favourable government policies. It works towards improving the situation of rural communities in the country. It carries out activities such as nationwide protests against free trade agreements and for higher price of rice, campaign to reform the national agricultural cooperative federation, annual Lee Kyung Hae commemoration and marathon, operation of a center to provide legal and financial services to farmers, conduct of a general assembly every two years, operation of a farmers' education center, rural communities exchange program to teach the youth about the importance of agriculture, and networking with other agricultural organizations in Asia.



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Women Advanced Farmers' Federation (WAFF)

Established in August 1996, WAFF is a federation of 70,000 women farmers in South Korea. It envisions unity, harmony, and development of women farmers. It provides education services; organizes exchanges between city and farm villages; upholds the protection of farmers' rights; cooperates with other farmer organizations; advocates for good agricultural policies; and administers the needs of its members. Besides, WAFF received the top prize for its business academy educational program from the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries in 2005.



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
